



ADP Vantage HCM – Clear Cache Job Aid

What is "Cache?"

"Browser Cache" is a temporary copy of the static content needed to display the pages being accessed. If the cache is not updated, the website could view an older version of the supporting content. By clearing cache, the browser is forced to fetch all the new content for the website again—so the most recent version can be viewed. Clearing cache will optimize the user experience with the update.

Steps to Clear Cache – Internet Explorer 8

Step	Action
1 1	Action Once your browser is open, click the Tools menu. Or, optionally you may simply press ^ Ctrl+ I Shift+ Delete to open the Delete Browsing History window (and skip step 2) Image: Cooper Windows Internet Explorer Image: Cooper Windows Internet Explorer

2	Click on Delete Browsing History

3	Select Temporary Internet Files. Important: make sure "Preserve Favorites website data" checkbox is NOT checked
4	Click the Delete button near the bottom of the window to delete your temporary files (i.e. clear your cache). You've successfully cleared Internet Explorer 8's Cache!
